Rollout Approaches

	Big Bang (Org Based) Rollout Lightning Experience to all users in your organization at the same time.	Phased (Persona Based) Rollout Lightning Experience gradually, in groups.	Hybrid Lightning Experience rollout can be tailored to your needs.
Pros	 Consistent user experience for all users Fastest (less expensive) implementation time Less change management, sharing communication, learning and enablement activities 	 Lowest risk approach Implementation process improves after each rollout (we learn as we go) Change management more manageable More focused training 	 Flexible to meet needs, (e.g., Big Bang upfront with main groups, then following up with remaining phases) Less risky than Big Bang, not focused on one big rollout
